



HOW TO SUCCESSFULLY NAVIGATE NIGERIA CUSTOMS







TO AVOID ISSUES AT CUSTOMS, PLEASE ADHERE TO THESE IMPORTANT GUIDELINES:



Accurate Product Descriptions: Ensure the category and name of the product precisely match the parcel contents. Avoid using general terms.



Declare the Danger Level: Specify if the goods are simple, contain liquids, or have batteries. Indicate if the parcel includes well-known brands.



Real Value and Quantity: Declare the true value and quantity of the goods. Customs officials may stop the parcel to verify the declared value against invoices.

TYPES OF PRODUCTS



SIMPLE GOODS

(do not contain liquids, batteries, or electronics):

- Clothing and shoes
- Bags and purses
- Battery-free toys
- Musical instruments without batteries
- Auto, motorcycle, bicycle parts



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TYPES OF PRODUCTS



(contain batteries and liquids):

 Request an MSDS certificate and DG declaration from the seller. Without these documents, the goods are classified as "prohibited" and must be returned within 7 days.

TYPES OF PRODUCTS



- Certain foods (e.g., fish snacks, meat snacks, spices, canned food)
- Cosmetics (e.g., talcum powder, leg balm, aloe gel)
- Manicure products (e.g., base gel, gel paint, manicure tapes, poly gel)
- Fresheners (e.g., home fragrance, car fragrance, air fresheners)
- Insect repellents (e.g., pest control products, insect traps, baby mosquito repellent)
- Stationery (e.g., hole punch, stapler, electromagnetic stapler, cooling systems)





IMPORTANT NOTES:

Contact us before purchasing to verify if your product can be delivered to Nigeria.



Do not undervalue goods; customs inspectors will reassess undervalued items, potentially leading to higher duties.



Keep official payment receipts as proof; customs do not accept payment screenshots or WeChat messages.



CUSTOMS CLEARANCE PROCESS:

- D of the customs inspector.
- Shipments are cleared as a whole per MAWB/Manifest, not individually.
- Customs duties are calculated based on invoice value and sent to D customers via email.
- High-value shipments (\$20 and above) are subject to duties. E-
- Payments are updated on the Skynet tracking system.



Parcels under \$50 may be exempt from clearance at the discretion

invoices for customs duties are sent to customers' registered emails.

DUTY CALCULATION FORMULA:

HS CODE RATE×CIF+OTHERS+VAT

Packages up to \$27 are duty-free. For packages over \$27, duty must be paid. The maximum declared value is \$800; above this, a license is required.

USEFUL INFORMATION:

Branded goods are not delivered to Nigeria. Verify if your shipment is branded before purchase. If branded goods arrive at the warehouse, return them to the seller or another warehouse.



Provide your user ID number to sellers and include it on boxes. This ensures warehouse specialists can identify your goods. Unidentified
